School and Community Facts

Founded in 1960, Pingree School is an independent, coeducational day school for grades 9–12, located 20 miles north of Boston. Due to its strong reputation, the school draws its 330 students from more than 42 communities. Pingree is very competitive and admissions decisions are based on school records, SSAT/ISEE testing, teacher recommendations and an interview. Ninety-nine percent of graduates go on to four-year colleges immediately following graduation.
