- Passion for working with and developing high school student-athletes
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Commitment to working collegially in a diverse community and communicating effectively with a diverse population
- Must have a valid driver's license and successfully complete a background check in order to work with minors
- Evening and weekend hours are required, as well as off-season support for the program
